ASEAN ANUG SCHOOL-BASED SCHOLARSHIP 2018

Methodist Girls' School (MGS) is offering the School-based scholarships for study in Singapore for the academic year 2018 on the sponsorship of the Association of Nanyang University Graduates (ANUG).

Methodist Girls' School was founded in 1887 by Sophia Blackmore, an Australian missionary sent to Singapore by the Methodist Episcopal Church in America to establish a school for girls. The MGS school-based scholarship was established in 1999 and 2018 will see the 20th intake of scholars under this scheme.

Terms of Scholarship

As part of our networking and globalisation process, we are fortunate to be able to offer fully-paid, non-bonding scholarships for foreign students.

The scholarship covers:

- An allowance of S\$2,200 per annum with hostel accommodation;
- A one-time settling-in allowance of S\$400; payable upon confirmation of scholarship;
- A one-time payment of the GCE 'O' Level examination fees;
- Exemption from school fees (miscellaneous fees not included);
- Subsidised medical care and insurance coverage;
 Note: Coverage for costs of dental treatment and medical expenses arising from a pre-existing illness are excluded.
- A return economy class air passage to and from Singapore at the start and end of the scholarship term, and after 2 years of study in Singapore (For West Malaysians, a S\$50 travel allowance will be paid in lieu of airfare).
 - No transport allowance will be given to scholars already studying in Singapore prior to the award of the scholarship.

The confirmation of the scholarship is subject to the successful candidates being certified medically fit by an appointed doctor.

There is no bond attached to the scholarship. However, scholars are required to execute a Scholarship Agreement with the Association of Nanyang University Graduates (ANUG), to complete the course and sit for the GCE 'O' Level Examination. If a scholar fails to complete the course of study, she will be liable to pay liquidated damages (LD) together with 10% compound interest per annum.

The scholarship allowance will be credited directly into the scholar's POSB/DBS bank account quarterly.

Criteria

The scholarship is offered to students who are:

- Girls born in the year 2003 to 2005 (12 to 14+ as at 1st January 2018) to study at Secondary 1 level (Y2018) in Singapore.
- Girls born in the year 2001 to 2003 (14 to 16+ as at 1st January 2018) to study at Secondary 3 level (Y2018) in Singapore.

Since this is a scholarship of considerable standing, students must be of high calibre. Students will be required to sit for entrance tests between **20 to 25 August 2017 (tentatively)**. You will be informed of the specific dates and details via email in due course.
